EL SALVADOR: Fourteen trade unionists

Amnesty International has been informed that the remaining nine members of *Federación Sindical Revolucionaria* (FSR, Revolutionary Trade Union Federation) have been released. Eight were released in July and one prior to then.

The 14 trade unionists were arrested on 19 January 1984 at a meeting called by the FSR to elect a new executive committee. According to reports, some of them were pressurized by both physical and psychological means to confirm that they were members of the *Fuerzas Populares de Liberación* (FPL), Popular Liberation Forces.

No further action is requested.
