Amnesty International has now received reports that the director of the Green Cross relief agency, Juan Francisco Zamora, was released from detention on or around 29 May 1982.

Juan Francisco Zamora and his 14-year-old nephew were abducted from Sr. Zamora's house by the Salvadorian security forces and subsequent reports indicated that they were being held by the National Police. Although confirmation has not yet been received, Amnesty International believes that Sr. Zamora's nephew has also been released.

No further action by Urgent Action participants is requested.
